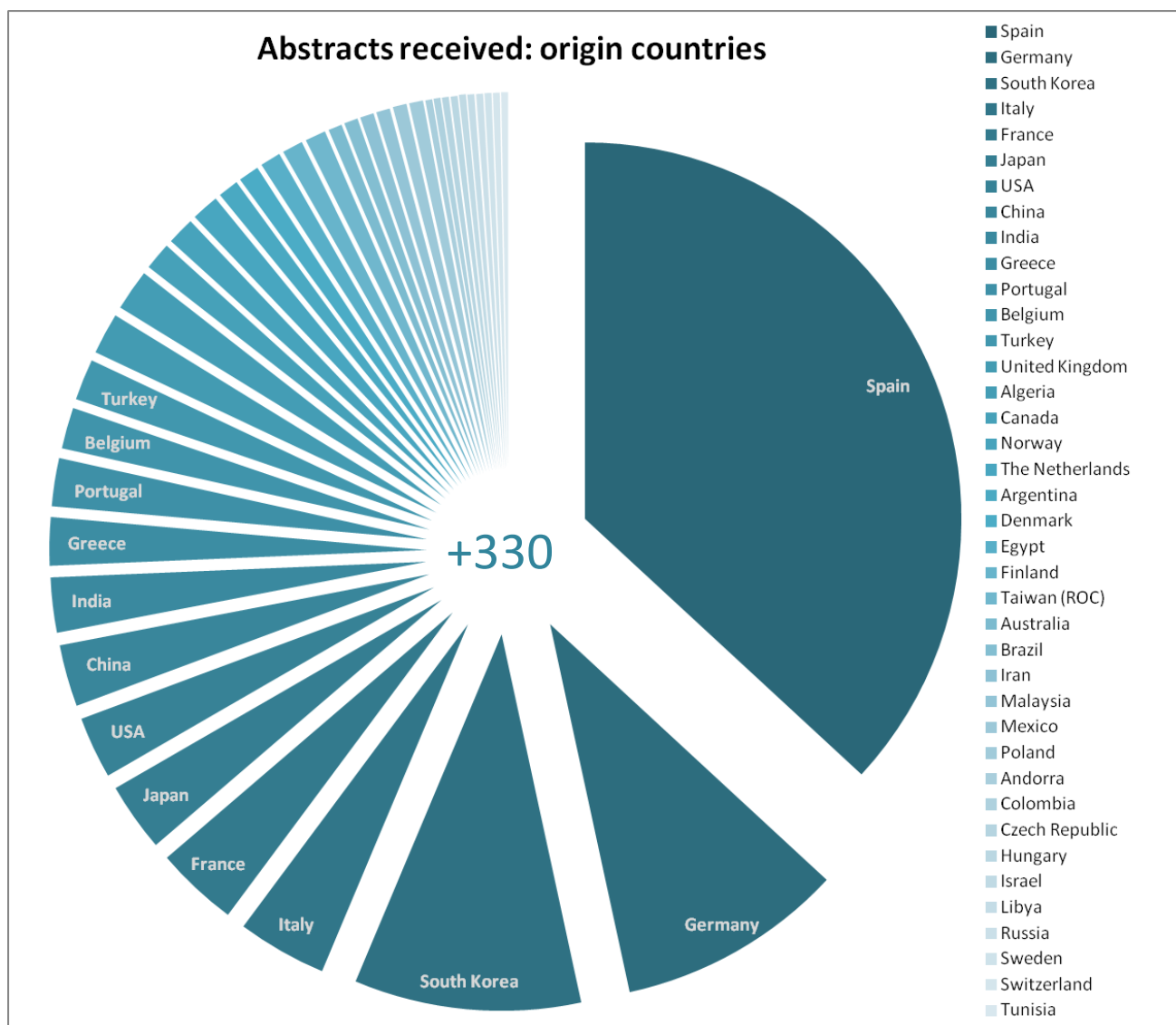


EHEC 2014: Call for Abstracts' final results

The European Hydrogen Energy Conference 2014 (EHEC 2014) will take place in Seville (Spain) from the 12th to the 14th of March 2014. The Call for Abstracts deadline initially announced was September 30th, and it was then extended to October 20th in intent to achieve even more diffusion and participation from the hydrogen community.

At October 30th, **more than 330 abstracts** have been received from **39 countries**, which means the EHEC 2014 is on its way to become one of main events of the year within the hydrogen and fuel cell sector.

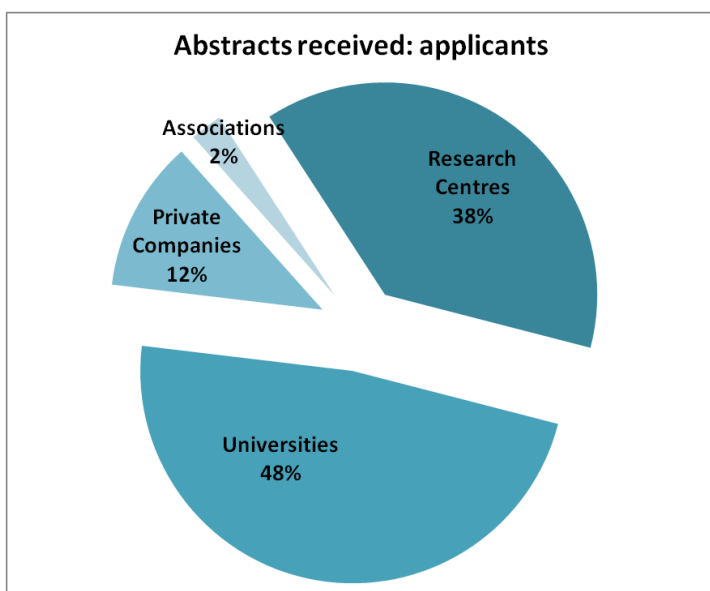
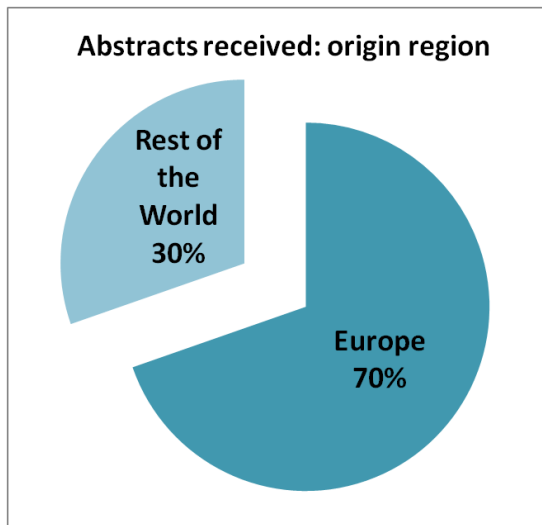

Despite being a mainly European-focused event, the EHEC has already attracted many specialists from all over the World, and about one third of the submitted abstracts belong to professionals placed beyond Europe's borders.

Continuing with the analysis, below you can see the different nature of the entities signing the received works. It seems that the main actors in the event will be universities and research centres, which amount about 85% of the received abstracts. However, some private companies will also present their advances and new developments during the Conference and some associations will showcase the results of some hydrogen initiatives.



All received abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee in order to guarantee their scientific quality and interest; the process has already begun and authors will be advised about the Committee's resolutions as soon as possible.
